### A Note to Judges

When a minor child or an incapacitated adult receives money through a personal injury claim, lump-sum back social security payment, or an unexpected inheritance, great care must be taken to ensure that the protected person's assets do not affect his or her means-tested government benefits like Medicaid and SSI. Additionally, a court must be assured that the protected person's assets are shielded against unscrupulous caretakers, opportunistic associates, or even well-intended but oftentimes misguided or unsophisticated family members and guardians.

Ordering the protected person's assets into a special needs trust will provide protection for the protected person's assets against all of the above dangers. When circumstances do not present the court with a trustworthy option for a trustee, a not-for-profit pooled special needs trust may be the answer. NFSNI's pooled trust provides each beneficiary with fully FDIC-insured accounts, fast disbursement turn-around times, and a commitment to provide the safest, most secured, and most dignified access to the trust in a manner that benefits only the beneficiary and in a manner that ensures continued benefits eligibility. We are here to ensure that the protected person's assets are used for their intended purpose(s)—and to fulfill the goal of a SNT, which is to provide for the highest possible material quality of life for a person with a disability.
